Well done to those who have received their reading rewards this week.



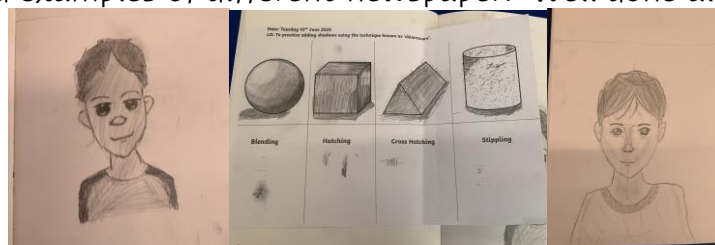
### Inter-schools Sporting Competition
